

LEN

LEN returns the length of a string value

Syntax

LEn([StrExpr](#)\$)

Arguments

- [StrExpr](#)\$ is a String Expression

Remarks

1. String Expression returns a real value containing N characters, where N=>0.
2. "[NullString](#)" is considered as a [DETERMINED](#) empty string.

Examples

LEN("445.02")

returns 6

LEN("[NullString](#)")

returns 0

LEN("Qknowledge Wageningen")

returns 16
