

MID\$

MID\$ returns the specified number of characters starting at Position% of the argument string value.

Syntax

MID\$(StrExpr\$, Position%, [Length%])

Arguments

- StrExpr\$ is a string expression
- Position% is the starting position of the substring
- Length% is an optional integer value containing the number of characters for the substring to contain

Remarks

1. NullString is considered as a DETERMINED empty string
2. If Length% is omitted, the full remaining part of the string is adopted.

Examples

MID\$("NullString", 3, 1) returns "NullString"

MID\$("Qnowledge Wageningen", 8, 6) returns "ge Wag"

MID\$("Qnowledge Wageningen", 8) returns "ge Wageningen"

MID\$("Qnowledge Wageningen", 8, 50) returns "ge Wageningen"
