

# RIGHT\$

RIGHT\$ returns the specified number of characters from the right side of the argument string value

## Syntax

RIGHT\$(StrExpr\$, Length%)

### Arguments

- StrExpr\$ is the string value to be shorten
- Length% is the number of characters to include

## Remarks

1. "NullString" is considered as a **DETERMINED** empty string.

## Examples

RIGHT\$("NullString", 3)

returns

"NullString"

---

RIGHT\$("Knowledge Wageningen", 10)

returns

"Wageningen"

RIGHT\$("Knowledge Wageningen", 0)

returns

"NullString"

returns

"NullString"

---

RIGHT\$("Knowledge Wageningen", 50)

returns

"Knowledge Wageningen"

---
