

@DEFINITION

The **object parameter** attribute @DEFINITION is used as starting tag for the script to initiate the [TeLiTab](#) Editor for an object. Always combined with [@ENDDEFINITION](#), [@LIST](#) and [@TABLE](#).

Syntax

Place @DEFINITION or @DEFINITION(ConditionCaption ParameterCondition) in the data slot of the parameter

Arguments

- ConditionCaption is a caption that is part of the condition. ParameterCondition is the condition to be true to use the @DEFINITION that will follow and is closed by [@ENDDEFINITION](#)

Remarks

Use this attribute to create a [TeLiTab](#) input script for an object. To be placed in the data slot of the parameter and to be closed with [@ENDDEFINITION](#). See also [@INQUIRY](#), [@LIST](#) and [@TABLE](#). The optional part between brackets enables you to define a script for a condition that is specified by the ParameterConditionpart. For instance, to conditions (the exact text for [parameter condition] is given), on being: **[NPowDrafts]=1**, in which in this case NPowDrafts is a parameter determining the number of draughts. And the other being:**[NPowDrafts]>1**.
