- The @NOBRANCHVAL attribute makes it impossible to read input values for this parameter being available in earlier instances of the same object, thus allowing its value to be calculated.
 - o If the @NŎBRANCHVAL is not present in a parameter, Quaestor will look in earlier instances of the current object and propose the
 - value found in there. In that case, it is not possible to empty the value cell, if you want it to be calculated.

 With @NOBRANCHVAL, input is asked, but if not provided, the system will attempt to calculate its value rather than inherit it from earlier object instances.
