

@NOFORWARD

The **parameter** attribute @NOFORWARD is used to define that this parameter is not invisible for forward screening, i.e., it is only presented to the user in a dialogue if the relation in which it occurs is proposed for selection.

Syntax

Place @NOFORWARD in the data slot of the parameter
