

@NOOPTIONS

The **string or object parameter** attribute @NOOPTIONS is used in an [OPTIONS] script to disable the functionality in the specified object(s).

Syntax

Place @NOOPTIONS:ObjectName_1,...,ObjectName_n in the data slot of the parameter

Arguments

- ObjectName_1,...,ObjectName_n is the list of objects (by their internal name) for which the data selection dialog will not be available

Remarks

In the data slot of a parameter you can create a script using an [OPTIONS] syntax that will enable you to invoke the database selection dialog.
