

@QPORT

The **parameter** attribute @QPORT is used to define the socket number for communication with a [Quaestor](#) server application, to be used in combination with [@QSERVER](#), [@REMOTEB](#) and [@REMOTEGOAL](#) attributes.

Syntax

Place @QPORT:SocketNr in the data slot of the parameter

Arguments

- SocketNr is the number of the socket over which is communicated with the [Quaestor](#) server defined by [@QSERVER](#).

Remarks

Use a free socket to communicate with server, e.g. 1120
