

@RECURSIVE

The **object parameter** attribute @RECURSIVE is used to define an object as recursive so it can contain instances of itself.

Syntax

Place @RECURSIVE in the data slot of the parameter

Arguments

- The standard QEntity object is a @RECURSIVE object. Use it in any object that may contain instances of itself, also if indirectly, e.g. use it in Object1 if structures such as Object1.Object2.Object1 are expected.
