

@REMOVE

The **string parameter** attribute @REMOVE is used in combination with [@BINARY](#) in a (sub) goal parameter to ensure that the document file is deleted after including it as binary in this string parameter.

Syntax

Place @REMOVE in the data slot of the parameter

Arguments

- Ensures that a result file is deleted after inclusion as binary object in a solution. Can be used for results of the [WINWORD\\$\(\)](#), [MACRO\(\)](#) and [EXCEL#\(\)](#) functions.
