

# @RUNEXCELMACRO

The **string relation or constraint** attribute @RUNEXCELMACRO is used in the [EXCEL#\(\)](#) function to execute a macro in the Excel sheet template immediately upon opening the Excel sheet.

## Syntax

Place @RUNEXCELMACRO:MacroName in the data slot of the relation or constraint

## Arguments

- MacroName is the name of the VBA macro in the Excel sheet

## Remarks

[Quaestor](#) does not have knowledge about the content of the VBA macro. This functionality inside the VBA macro remains the responsibility of the Knowledge Engineer.
