

@EQEXPLAINTELITAB

The **TeLiTab** parameter attribute @EQEXPLAINTELITAB is used to define a string or expression to present a Telitab value in the workbase. See also [@EQEXPLAIN](#), [@EQCOMBOEXPLAIN](#) and [@EQEXPLAINVALUE](#).

Syntax

Place @EQEXPLAINTELITAB:=StringValue or @EQEXPLAINTELITAB:=[TeLiTab](#)#.ParameterName in the data slot of the parameter

Arguments

- StringValue is a sentence to be displayed; [TeLiTab](#)#.ParameterName refers to a specific value in the [TeLiTab](#) which is the value for the parameter containing this attribute
