

@HIDE

The **parameter** attribute @HIDE is used to define that the parameter or object is not shown in the workbase.

Syntax

Place @HIDE:Expression in the data slot of the parameter

Arguments

- Expression is a logical expression to specify when to hide the parameter value. Note that the expression feature is made with the focus on [Taxonomy](#) knowledge bases.

Remarks

Domain experts and knowledge engineers can show the hidden data in both the knowledge browser and in the workbase by toggeling the hide mode with Ctrl-H or by selecting the option 'Show hidden data' in Options>Modeler
