

# @POINTER

The **string parameter** attribute @POINTER is used to define a [TeLiTab](#) (string) parameter as pointer and not as object container.

## Syntax

Place @POINTER in the data slot of the parameter

## Remarks

If used in a Telitab parameter that is computed by means of an object, it will be given the name of the object instead of the contents of the object, e.g. TelitabPar#=ObjectPar(@Goal\_1,...,@Goal\_n,@Arg\_1:ArgVal\_1,...,@Arg\_m:ArgVal\_m), TalitbPar# will become the value "ObjectPar" instead of the ObjectPar contents.
