

@WBDIM

The **parameter** attribute @WBDIM is used to define an alternative presentation for the dimension (Note, this will not overrule the given dimension for the dimension analysis).

Syntax

Place @WBDIM :DimensionName in the data slot of the parameter

Arguments

- DimensionName is the presentation name of the dimension in the [Workbase](#) and the [Knowledge Browser](#). It overrules the defined dimension in the dimension slot. **Please note that this does not replace a dimension but is an addition to it. So first provide the proper SI dimension (or make it non-dimensional first) and then provide an additional presentation name.**

Remarks

This attribute is useful to present parameters with pseudo dimensions such as "report" or "picture". See also [Documentation of knowledge](#).
