

@TEXTLASTDELIMITER

The **string relation or constraint** attribute @TEXTLASTDELIMITER is used to define the delimiter between the last two text elements of the result created by a relation that is referring to a [TeLiTab](#) with multi case text values. Used with [@TEXTDELIMITER](#).

Syntax

Place @TEXTLASTDELIMITER:Delimiter in the data slot of the relation or constraint

Arguments

- Delimiter is the delimiter you want to specify. This is a string, so use quotes and include spaces if necessary

Remarks

When you have a [TeLiTab](#) with multi case values, you can make a sentence of this dataset by creating a relation, for example, Sentence\$=[TeLiTab](#)#. TextValue\$, and using [@TEXTDELIMITER](#):", " and @TEXTLASTDELIMITER :"," and " to place comma's and an and between the values.
