

@CHANGEDRED

The **value or string parameter** attribute @CHANGEDRED is used to indicate that the Entity parameter with [@MODIFY](#) and [@INPUTCOLOR](#) is shown in red after change.

Syntax

Place @CHANGEDRED in the data slot of the parameter

Remarks

By using this attribute in combination with the [@MODIFY](#) and [@INPUTCOLOR](#) attribute for a parameter in the Entity of a [Taxonomy](#), you can make the cell color behind a value turn red when a user has modified it. This makes sure users are aware that proposed values are overruled.
