

ENDECODE\$

ENDECODE\$ returns a BASE64 encoded or decoded document

Syntax

ENDECODE\$([CodingType\\$](#), Document\$)

Arguments

- CodingType\$ (a [StrExp](#)) can be:
 - a. "BASE64ENCODE", encode in Base64 code;
 - b. "BASE64ENCODE", decode from Bas64 code;
 - c. "BASE64ENCODE", encode in Base64Binary code;
 - d. "BASE64ENCODE", decode from Base64Binary code;
- [Document\\$](#) is the document that should be encoded or decoded.

Examples

```
ENDECODE$("BASE64ENCODE", "Qnowledge B.V")
```

returns

```
"UW5vd2xIZGdlIEluVg=="
```

```
ENDECODE$("BASE64ENCODE", "UW5vd2xIZGdlIEluVg==")
```

returns

```
"Qnowledge B.V."
```
