

ASC

ASC returns the ASCII value of a byte.

Syntax

ASC([StrExp](#)\$)

Arguments

- [StrExp](#)\$ is, in this case, **a single byte or string with length 1**.

Remarks

1. If you use a string which is longer than 1 byte, you will get a fatal error message

Examples

ASC("A")

returns

65

ASC("3")

returns

51
