The **parameter** attribute @PROPAGATE_PARENT is used to define for this particular parameter that any change made to its value should not only be propagated within the current entity but also in its immediate parent.

Syntax

Place @PROPAGATE_PARENT in the data slot of the parameter

Arguments

Remarks

This attribute is used to define for this particular parameter that any change made to its value should not only be propagated within the current entity and also in its immediate parent. This allows e.g. that data is gathered in an entities parent can be used in calculations within the current entity, for example for creating a graph or sketch in Html5.
