

@OUTPUTNONE

The **relation** or **constraint** attribute @OUTPUTNONE is used to define that the output file of a satellite programs can be empty.

Syntax

Place @OUTPUTNONE in the data slot of the relation or constraint

Remarks

- Please note that [Quaestor](#) will not wait for the process to finish. In other words, this is NOT the correct attribute to catch crashing external processes. In that case you rather use the [@ERROR](#) or the [@ONNOVALUE](#) attributes
