Expression Editor

The editor is divided in two parts:

In the upper part you can write your expression, with assistance of a dropdown selection box to assist with selection of allowed and existing parameters, [intrinsic](#) functions and available knowledge base functions and [ToolTip](#) functionality to assist with the use of the syntax of functions. Moreover, corresponding brackets are shown in equal color.

The lower part of for [attributes](#) and data. It is called the data slot of the Expression Editor.
